PRIVATE LESSONS (OPTIONAL)

Young Artists may choose to take private lesson during SPACC. There is an extra charge of \$55/30 minute lesson. Young Artists sign up with Sara Gorby at camp on a daily bases for lessons. You must fill out a private lesson sheet and have your credit card online. This form will be sent out with your precamp packet. It will also be sent out via email, on the website and extra forms will be available at camp check in on June 27th.
