**SPACC** (Summer Performing Arts Conservatory Camp) is a residential camp with a conservatory model. This means young artists focus on process not performance. SPACC is held at Camp Perkins on Lake Perkins near Alturas Lake in the Sawtooth Mountains. It is a perfect setting for us to focus our energy away from the distractions of technology and our everyday lives.

#### PRIVATE LESSONS (OPTIONAL)

Young Artists may choose to take private lessons during SPACC. There is an extra charge of \$55/30 minute lesson. Young Artists sign up with Sara Gorby at camp daily for lessons. You

must fill out a private lesson sheet and have your credit card online. This form will be sent out with your pre-camp packet. It will also be sent out via email, on the website and extra forms will be available at camp check-in on June 24th.
